

Testimony Guide: The Next Chapter

Being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.
-Philippians 1:6

When you received Christ as your Savior your personal “God Story” began. It’s so important that you are able to clearly communicate how you came to understand your need for a personal relationship with Christ. But your salvation experience is only the beginning of your testimony; it’s equally important to share how your daily life is impacted by your decision to follow Christ. Each day is a new chapter ~ an opportunity to expect God to show up in your life and reflect on your response. Here are a few questions to choose from and guide your thoughts as you prepare to share what God is doing in your life.

How has God spoken to you through His Word, the Bible?

Direct my footsteps according to your word; let no sin rule over me. Psalm 119:33

- Do you spend time daily in God’s Word? Is there a specific devotional book or reading plan that you use?
- Has the Lord used scripture to provide guidance for a decision, convict you of sin, remind you of a promise, etc.?

Share an example of answered prayer in your life.

Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows. James 1:17

- How have you seen God provide for your family?
- How have you seen God work through a difficult situation in your life or someone you know?
- How has God blessed you recently?

When was the last time you shared your faith and what happened?

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses... Acts 1:8

- Do you pray for opportunities to share your faith? Are you aware when God provides them?
- How did you feel before you presented the Gospel? After?
- Have you continued to pray for that person, regardless of their response?

How are you involved in your local church?

Do not neglect your gift. 1 Timothy 4:14

- Share how you have applied a biblical truth from a recent sermon at your church.
- Why do you think it’s important to be part of a youth ministry?
- What are some of the gifts (abilities and qualities) God has given you? How are you using them?

How has being a part of First Priority impacted your life?

As iron sharpens iron, so one man sharpens another. Proverbs 27:17

- How and when did you first learn about First Priority?
- Have you invited friends?
- What have you learned from being a part of the club or serving in leadership?
