Volusia County

This school year marked a major milestone as we launched our first-ever club in Volusia County at Spruce Creek High School. This new beginning represents not just a geographic expansion, but a spiritual one—bringing hope and Gospel conversations to a brand-new community.

Orlando Area

In the greater Orlando region, momentum is building. We now have active clubs meeting at Horizon High, Windy Ridge Middle School, and Ocoee High School. Students are coming together each week to grow in their faith, build community, and share the Gospel on their campuses.

Miami-Dade County

We also launched our first elementary school club in Miami-Dade at BridgePrep Academy of Doral. Reaching younger students earlier opens the door for lifelong transformation and deeper connections to local churches.



Gen Z and Gen Alpha are growing up in a world marked by noise, confusion, and disconnection—but they're more spiritually open than we may realize.


65%
